

6.0 HEAD STUDTorque Specifications

- **1.** Pre-clean all surfaces, ensure a clean, true thread in block. Chase the threads if necessary.
- 2. Compare Bolt length and thread pattern to ensure correct fitment before beginning the installation process.
- **3.** Hand thread studs into block, and snug down with a wrench, DO NOT TIGHTEN. If choosing to use a thread locker make sure to finish the torque process before it sets up.
- **4.** Lubricate the upper threads of the studs, nuts and washers with the provided torque lubricant.
- 5. Hand tighten all the hardware
- **6.** Begin tightening sequence REPEAT THE SEQUENCE (1-10) ON THE DIAGRAM BELOW WITH EACH TORQUE STEP (A, B, C, D)

Step C 150 ft lbs
